IMPORTANT DATES FOR SENIORS

Jayhawk Days (year-round) Includes a presentation, walking tour, optional housing tour, and optional academic meeting

Senior Days:

Monday, September 16th
Monday, September 30th
Friday, October 11th
Monday, October 21st
Monday, October 28th
Monday, November 4th
Monday, November 11th
Friday, November 22nd

There is a small fee, and online registration is required for Senior Days. All seniors must register separately. Registrations are accepted on a space-available basis.



Applications

There are several applications to fill out for KU:

- Admissions Application: Apply NOW
- Scholarship Application: Apply by November 1 for KU's premier scholarships
- Housing Application: Apply *early* if you plan to live in the residence halls so a spot is reserved for you
- Financial Aid: Apply by March 1 for grants, loans, and work-study programs to help pay for college.

Admissions Requirements

If you graduate from high school and achieve any one of these 3 criteria you are eligible for admission to KU.

1. Achieve a 21 or higher composite score on ACT OR,
2. Rank in top 1/3 of your graduating class, OR
3. Complete the Kansas pre-college curriculum with a 2.0 GPA or higher.
