Applications

There are several applications to fill out for K-State:

- Admissions Application: Apply NOW
- Scholarship Application: Apply by November 1 for K-State's premier scholarships
- Housing Application: Apply early if you plan to live in the residence halls so a spot is reserved for you
- Financial Aid: Apply by March 1 for grants, loans, and work-study programs to help pay for college.

Admissions Requirements

If you graduate from high school and achieve any one of these 3 criteria you are eligible for admission to KSU.

1. Achieve a 21 or higher composite score on ACT OR,
2. Rank in top 1/3 of your graduating class, OR
3. Complete the Kansas pre-college curriculum with a 2.0 GPA or higher.
